MOVEMBER: TrueNTH Global Registry- Prostate Cancer Outcomes

**SUMMARY OF PROJECT**

This project aims to significantly improve the physical and mental health of men treated for prostate cancer by:

- systematically measuring clinical and patient-reported outcomes on men diagnosed with prostate cancer, regardless of their management approach, using the ICHOM Localized Prostate Cancer Standard Set on a prospective basis in multiple clinical sites across the 13 countries participating in this Movember Foundation -funded study;
- systematically measuring other key elements of care that have the potential to impact outcomes – e.g. pre- and post-treatment care practices, multi-disciplinary teams;
- comparing and sharing (de-identified) outcomes between Participating Sites and the Local Data Centres recruiting patients;
- analysing the variations in outcomes to understand the key drivers that deliver the best possible outcomes for men with prostate cancer; and
- mobilising the exchange of knowledge within the TrueNTH Global Registry Members and beyond.
